Building a better, healthier future for you

In 2018, Southeast Georgia Health System began a three-year, \$140 million master renovation and expansion project on its Brunswick Campus to help ensure it can continue to meet health care needs as the communities it serves grow and patient volumes increase.

Inside and out, construction crews are busy working on the Emergency Care Center, Surgical Services Tower and new Inpatient Floor, as well as upgrades to the Central Energy Plant to accommodate the expansion.

“This project is a prime example of our commitment to meeting our communities’ needs,” says Michael D. Scherneck, president and CEO, Southeast Georgia Health System. “Everyone at some point needs health care, and we’ve seen dramatic growth in patient volumes in recent years. We’re dedicated to providing the services they need — and adding advanced technologies and treatments to expand services.”

Opportunities to help

The project is possible thanks to tax-exempt revenue bonds and the generosity of donors. However, the project isn’t totally funded yet. That’s where the 20-20 Vision Campaign, conducted by the Southeast Georgia Health System Foundation, comes in. The Foundation launched the campaign in March 2018. A goal of \$8 million was established, and more than \$5 million has been raised so far.
